- Nuclear & Emerging Tech: Overseeing the Romanian Nuclear and Radioactive Waste Agency and coordinating the national EU Hydrogen Strategy implementation.
- International Affairs: Leading Romania's representation at the EU Council of Ministers (Energy), OECD accessions, and institutional dialogues with the World Bank, IMF, EBRD, etc.

Mr. Drăgan has held several executive leadership positions in the field of energy and trading, e.g. country manager Repower Romania, Swiss backed energy company and chairman of Romgaz SA' BoDs, Romanian national gas company.
